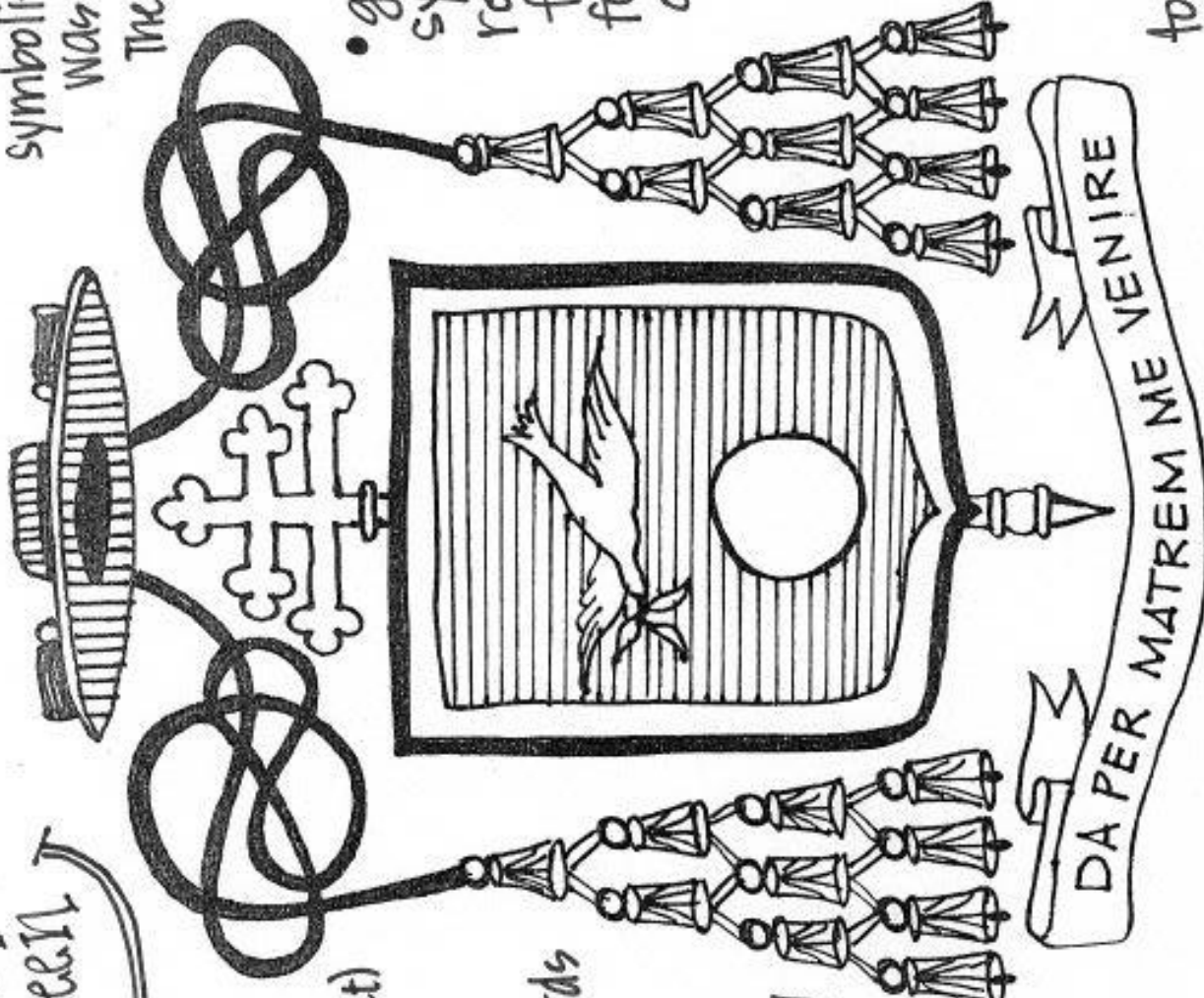


# The Coat of Arms of Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen

- archiepiscopal cross (2 horizontal bars) symbolizes that he was an Archbishop. The cross is gold.



- green galero (hat) with ten green fiocchi (bows) hanging from cords on each side

- The sheen family was originally from Ireland. Sheen in Gaelic means "peaceful". The dove holding an olive branch symbolizes peace. The shield is blue.

- golden globe symbolizes his role as director for the society for the propagation of the Faith

- the Latin motto says "Grant that I may come to Thee through Thy Mother" showing his desire to know Jesus by knowing Mary
